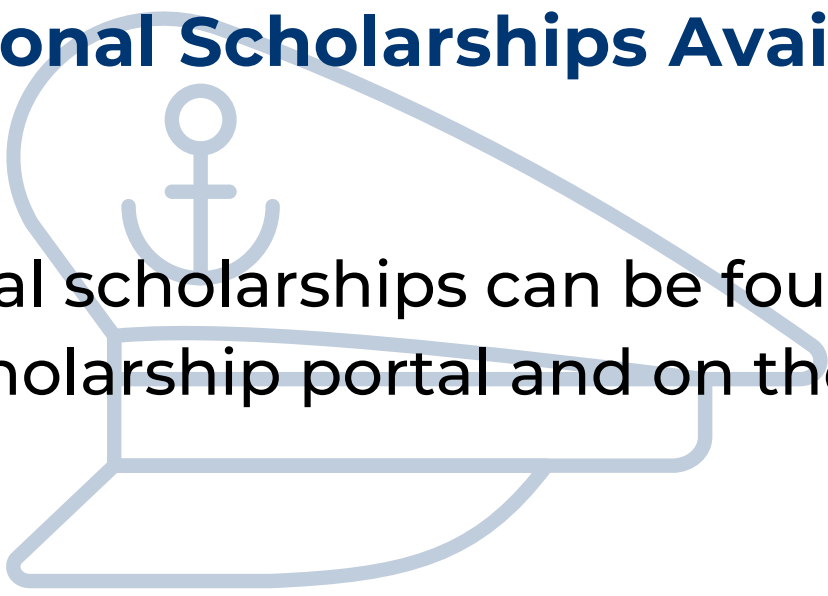

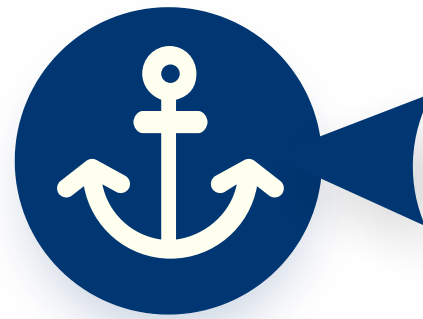

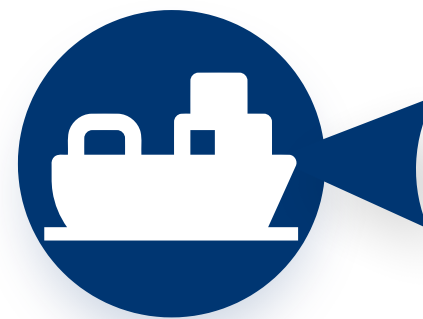
- Up to \$2500

Great Lakes Task Force Scholarship

Scholarship is awarded to students in the Deck or Engineering Officer programs.

- Up to \$1000
- 3.0+ GPA
- Enrolled in 12+ credits
- Be a U.S. Citizen



Blue Water Shipmaster's Scholarship

Scholarship is awarded to students enrolled at the Great Lakes Maritime Academy who are from either St. Clair County, Michigan or Lambton County Ontario, Canada.

- Up to \$1000
