The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transition of students from Career and Technical Education (CTE) program to a related program at NMC. The college will award credit to students of the CTC according to the conditions and requirements listed below.

Conditions/Requirements:

- 1. Student must enroll at NMC and apply for articulated credit within two (2) years of their high school graduation date.
- 2. Student must enroll in a related program of study at NMC for credits to apply to an associate degree or certificate.
- 3. Student must complete the CT program with a grade of B or better and achieve the required competencies to articulate the class.
- 4. NMC instructor will evaluate the student's learning based on the course objectives, course work, and assessments, and if necessary, administer a competency evaluation.
