1. Student must enroll at NMC and apply for articulated credit within two (2) years of their high school graduation date.
2. Students must enroll in a related program of student (Engineering Technology, Construction Technology, or similar program housed within the Technical Division) at NMC for credits to apply to an associate degree or certificate.
3. Student must complete the first and second years of Wexford-Missaukee CTC Computers, Networking, and Electronics (CNET) class with a grade of B or better,



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achieve the required competencies to articulate the class and receive endorsement from Wexford-Missaukee CTC Computers, Networking, and Electronics (CNET) instructor(s).

4. NMC instructor will evaluate the student's learning based on the course objectives, course work, and assessments, and if necessary a NMC written competency evaluation.
5. Articulation credits are subject to fees.






