- Review NMC's Applying for Financial Aid page
- Create an account on studentaid.gov before starting your FAFSA form. The FAFSA student and parent should create a Federal Student Aid ID 3-5 days prior to completing the FAFSA
- Bring social security cards or exact info from them (both students and parents) or Alien Registration Number
- Bring a digital or paper copy of their 2023 tax return (both parents and students)
- Bring a laptop or tablet (Limited Chromebooks will be available.)

In-district students (Grand Traverse County)

NO GPA or household income requirements!

- Community College Guarantee will cover all tuition and fees for the high school class of 2024 and beyond!

Out-of-district students

- Community College Guarantee will cover more than half the cost (half the tuition and all fees). Pell grant funds can be used to cover the out-of-district difference

What's required?

- Must enroll within 15 months of high school graduation
- Must be enrolled full time (at least 12 credits, typically 4 classes)
- For more information go to michigan.gov/mistudentaid

Bonus features:

- No maximum credit limit
- Students can earn more than one associate degree or certificate
- Prepare for a bachelor's: take classes needed as prerequisites for transfer to a bachelor degree program
