Conditions/Requirements:

- 3. Student completes the Culinary and/or Pastry Arts class with a grade of B or better and achieves the required competencies to articulate the class.
- 4. Student must send a letter of recommendation from their Northwest Education Services Career Tech Center instructor with their application.
- 5. NMC instructor evaluates the Northwest Education Services Career Tech Center student learning based on the course objectives, course work, assessments, and, if necessary, an NMC competency evaluation.
